

Interoperability issues 21022016

- Interoperability issues:
 - These models could not be approved for TravelTales:
 - Sony Ericsson Xperia1 (X1)
 - OS: Windows Mobile[*] 6.1
 - JSR 135: File activation seems not to work
 - JSR 179: Location updates seem sporadic
 - JSR 179: API is not officially supported by X1
 - HTC HD2
 - OS: Windows Mobile[*] 6.5
 - General J2ME installation issue
 - Workaround: Change OS to Android… ☺
- [*]: Windows Mobile is the old OS from Microsoft. It is completely different from what is used in e.g. the NOKIA Lumia series. The new OS from Microsoft is called Windows Phone.

Other types status 21022016

Windows Phone

 The plan for TravelTales is to extend it to work on this platform at some point in the future

Blackberry

 In general TravelTales is expexted not to be supported on this platform in the near future
